Battle of Resaca Reenactment

CANCELED

After much deliberation and discussions with staff, emergency personnel, and other involved support agencies, a hard decision was made to **cancel Resaca 2020**.

With the Georgia “Shelter in Place” in effect until April 30th and the “State of Emergency” declared until May 15th concerning COVID-19, this has governed our action. We will not know if these dates will be extended. This does not include other state’s orders or safety requirements.

With the primary concern of having troops and visitors from around the nation traveling to Resaca the decision came down to safety for everyone involved. Secondly, COVID-19 has made a great impact on our efforts to prepare the site due to safety concerns for our dedicated team of volunteers from both the Resaca Reenactment staff and the Georgia Division of Reenactors Association.

We apologize for any inconvenience and we truly appreciate everyone’s understanding. We are disappointed with having to take this action since we have a lot time and funds already invested on site preparation this year. When the present situation clears up, we still have to get the site preparation completed as per our agreement to use the site.

An event delay was not possible due to our legal agreement limiting the reenactment dates.

Plans are underway for the 157th Anniversary of the Battle of Resaca to be scheduled on May 15th & 16th of 2021.

All pre-registration will be refunded by mail no later than May 15th as they were received.
